

# Stanwell House

## First Time Visitors

Stanwell House Hotel, 14-15 High Street, Lymington, SO41 9AA, 01590 677123.

If you are visiting Stanwell House for the first time then we have prepared some information, including directions, parking, check in details and collection and concierge services. ### From the M27:

From the east, take the first exit off the M27 Westbound, signposted Lyndhurst and New Forest. At the roundabout take the first exit, signposted Cadnam. Bear round to the right and at the roundabout take the third exit, signposted Lyndhurst. Continue forward on the A337, entering Lyndhurst.

Turn left onto the High Street, signposted all traffic routes and through the High Street turn right onto Gosport Lane, A35, signposted Lymington. Keep in the left-hand lane and bear left continuing along Gosport Lane, A337, signposted Lymington. At the T-junction turn left onto Clay Hill, A337, signposted Lymington. Continue along A337, entering Brockenhurst.

Continue over the level crossing, and follow A337 out of Brockenhurst. At Somerfield roundabout continue straight over, entering Lymington. At roundabout take first exit, onto Marsh Lane, and follow. Continue straight over the two mini-roundabouts and follow road to the bottom of Lymington High Street.

### From Bournemouth:

Leaving Bournemouth, continue on the Wessex Way, A338 in eastbound direction. Turn off the Wessex Way at unnamed road, signposted Boscombe. At the Cooper Dean roundabout take the third exit onto Castle Lane East, A3060 signposted Lyndhurst. At the traffic lights continue over following A3060. At Iford roundabout take the first exit onto Christchurch Road, A35, signposted Lyndhurst.

Continue along the A35, entering Christchurch. At the roundabout take the second exit onto Barrack Road, A35, signposted Lyndhurst. At Bailey roundabout take the first exit following the A35. At Fountain roundabout take the second exit onto the Christchurch bypass, signposted Lyndhurst. At the Somerford roundabout take the second exit continuing onto Highcliffe Road, A337 and continue. At Hoburne roundabout take second exit continuing along Highcliffe Road through Highcliffe.

At the Milestone roundabout take the second exit onto Lymington Road, A337, and continue forward entering New Milton. At roundabout take second exit following A337, signposted Lymington and entering Downton. Bear left onto Milford Road, continuing along A337, entering Everton. Continue along A337 entering Lymington. Continue in right-hand lane and bear right onto Queen Street at one-way system. Bear left onto the top of Lymington High Street.

## From Southampton:

From Southampton, follow directions West leaving on the A35, Millbrook Road. Continue along the dual-carriageway over the Millbrook and Westover flyovers. Continue along the A35 and at the Rushington roundabout take the second exit, onto Spicers Hill. At roundabout take the first exit, onto Hunters Hill, following the A35 and entering Ashurst.

Follow A35, entering Lyndhurst, and continue round to the left, Gosport Lane, signposted Lymington. At the T-junction turn left onto Clay Hill, A337, signposted Lymington. Continue along A337, entering Brockenhurst. Continue over the level crossing, and follow A337 out of Brockenhurst. At Somerfield roundabout continue straight over, entering Lymington. At roundabout take first exit, onto Marsh Lane, and follow. Continue straight over the two mini-roundabouts and follow road to the bottom of Lymington High Street.

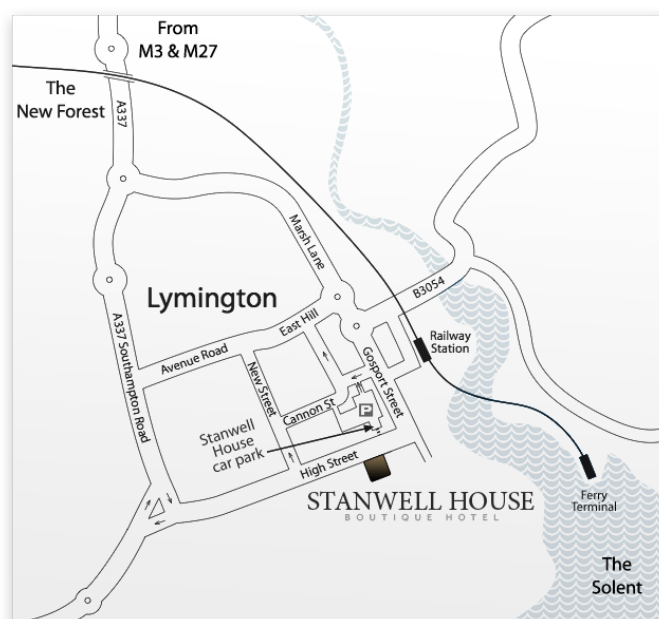
## Entering Lymington:

If you are entering Lymington from Beaulieu or the New Forest, you should continue along the bottom of the High Street and follow the road round to the right. Stanwell House is located a short way along on the left hand side. If, however, you are coming in at the top of town (usually from the West and Brockenhurst) then follow the one-way system round to the top of St Thomas' Street and continue down the High Street where Stanwell House will be found towards the bottom on the right hand side.

## Parking:

Due to its prime location on historic Lymington's High Street, there are some restrictions on parking which you should consider before arriving. Stanwell House has a small off-site car park with only 12 spaces. The hotel car park's postcode is SO41 9BR. Due to the limited amount of spaces, it is available on a first-come-first-serve basis. A ticket is required for the hotel car park, and one may be obtained from Reception on check in. Should the hotel car park be full the public car park (which lies adjacent to the hotel car park) in Canon Street may be used. Please note, the public parking is split into two areas of which one is Long Term and one is Short Term (3 hours Max). Both long and short stay parking options may be paid for using the Ringo app (the long stay parking location is 2553). Most of our guests choose to pull up outside the hotel on the High Street to unload their luggage and then move their cars to either the hotel parking or the Canon Street public parking.

Please see the map for details. If you have any problems finding us please do not hesitate to call and we will guide you. Parking on the high street is for 1 hour only and free between 6pm and 8am Sunday - Friday. There is no parking on the high street late on Friday night due to the charter market setting up extremely early on a Saturday Morning. No parking is allowed on the high street on Saturday until after 6pm.



**Checking In:**

Your room will be available from 3.00pm on the day of check in and check out is at 11.00am. If you arrive before 3pm and your room is ready, we will happily check you in early, however this cannot be guaranteed. If your room is not ready, you are welcome to park in our car park (subject to availability), leaving your luggage in the car and enjoy the hotel facilities and Lymington town, until your room is ready. We do not have the facilities in the hotel to store luggage.
