well-structured, velvety smooth and rounded body.

22. Chateauneuf-du-pape "Alchimie", Domaine des £71 Collier, France

A black cherry, strawberry, tapenade and tobacco nose with a full palate full of spice, red fruits and fleshy tannins before a long and persistent finish.

- 23. Pinot Noir Jaffelin, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France (V) £34 This wine has ripe and jammy nuances of dark fruits such as blackcurrant, blackberry and black cherry.
