Carignan, Grenache and Syrah from Rhône valley growers make for wine that is round and ripe, full of red berries and some spicy, yet well-integrated tannin.
21. Mommessin Beaujolais Village, Chateau de £46
Montmelas, France
Pronounced nose of black berries and plums with a well-structured, velvety smooth and rounded body.
22. Chateauneuf-du-pape "Alchimie", Domaine des £71
Collier, France
A black cherry, strawberry, tapenade and tobacco nose with a full palate full of spice, red fruits and fleshy tannins before a long and persistent finish.
23. Pinot Noir Jaffelin, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France (V) £34
This wine has ripe and jammy nuances of dark fruits such as blackcurrant, blackberry and black cherry.
24. Sangiovese, Primi Soli, Italy £33
An elegant combination of cherries and red fruits with a soft tannin structure.
25. Via Alta Merlot Reserva, Chile £32
Fruity with velvety undertones, extremely palatable with a rich and concentrated flavour.
