

Champagne & Sparkling

Da Luca Prosecco, Veneto, Italy £8 Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut, Champagne, France £15

This Grand Brut has fine bubbles, which release deliciously floral, slightly honeyed fruit aromas. It shows fresh fruit such as white peach on the palate and has an elegant finish.

Gusbourne Brut Reserve, Kent, England £17

Highlights of red fruit aromas such as cherry and strawberry, then developing into notes of fresh pastry. The finish is clean and fresh and gives tones of citrus and stone fruit.

Perrier-Jouët Blanc de Blanc, Champagne, France £33

Enticing aromas of hedgerow flowers – elderberry, acacia, and honeysuckle – and tangy citrus. On the palate, its mineral freshness lingers into a surprisingly smooth, mellow finish.

Fresh, vibrant and bursting with aromas of grapefruit, pear and summer flowers with a joyful parade of lemon and lime flavours balanced by juicy acidity.

La Campagne, Viognier, Languedoc, £6 £8.50 £12 France (V)

Dry with all the classic characteristics of the Viognier grape, exhibiting peaches, dried apricots and floral aromas.

Allumea, Organic Chardonnay | Grillo, £7 £9.80 £14 Sicilia, Italy (V)

This wine has an elegant pale-yellow hue, with intense aromas of pineapple and lemon. The palate is fresh and crisp, with a great minerality and a long and lingering finish.

Petal & Stem, Sauvignon Blanc, £7 £9.50 £14 Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand

This wine expresses pure fruit flavours of guava and passionfruit, with underlying notes of grapefruit and blackcurrant leaf, combining to create a wine that is refreshingly zesty and nicely balanced on the finish.

Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Chenin £8 £10.50 £16 Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa

An elegant and full-bodied wine. Flavours of melon, white peach and almond blossom and a hint of minerality that adds to the elegance of the wine. Masterfully oaked, this wine is textured and creamy on the mid-palate with a lively, crisp finish.

Rosé Wine

A delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas and flavours.

AIX de Provence Rosé, France £8 £11.30 £16

The nose is fresh and fragrant, with a palette that is dry yet delicate and youthful. This rose offers classy notes of watermelon, strawberries and flowers.

Red Wine

Saint Marc Cabernet Sauvignon, Pays £5.50 £7.50 £11 d'Oc. France (V)

Classic notes of red berry, blackcurrant and cherry fruits. Clean and persistent on the finish.

Jaffelin, Pinot Noir, Vin de Pays d'Oc, £6 £8.50 £12 France (V)

This wine has ripe and jammy nuances of dark fruits such as blackcurrant, blackberry and black cherry with toast, vanilla and soft tannins.

Nieto Senetiner Malbec, Mendoza, £6.50 £9 £13 Argentina (V)

Soft and juicy with flavours of berries, plum, figs and a smoky vanilla finish.

Veramonte Organic Carmenere, £7 £9.80 £14 Colchagua Valley (V)

Notes of raspberry and cherry on the nose, ripe blue and black fruits being added on the medium-bodied palate; a touch of spice on the finish.

Masseria Borgo Del Truill Lucale Primitivo £7 £9.80 £14 Appasimento IGP Puglia, Italy.

Juicy with incredible concentration. Aromas of blackcurrant, vanilla and chocolate. The palate is velvety, elegant and complex.

Chateau Grand Jauga Sauternes France (V)

A delicious combination of honeysuckle, apricot and marmalade, sweetness and acidity in perfect balance

Cascinone Palazzina, Muscato d'Asti, Piedmont, £7 Italy (V)

This Muscato reveals fresh and inviting notes of ripe apricot, peach, and honeysuckle, with a zesty citrus and grapefruit bite on the persistent finish.

Chapoutier Bila-Haut Banyuls Rimage, Banyuls, £11 France

This Banyuls has a powerful nose, shifting between black fruit and red berries, giving it a lovely freshness, subtly complemented by notes of cocoa. Great persistency with sweetness which develops gradually.

Royal Tokaji Blue Label 5 Puttonyos, Hungary £12

A medium amber colour with a nose of orange peel, figs and cinnamon. The sugar on the palate is well-balanced by the fine acidity, leading to a clean, refreshing finish.

Fernando de Castilla Classic Pedro Ximenez, Jerez, £12 Spain (V)

The palate shows an array of flavours from coffee, liquorice, sweet tobacco and prunes to figs, raisins, tea and a dozen other fleeting scents. A decadent wine, that everyone must try at least once.

Champagne & Sparkling 750ml £48 100. Da Luca, Prosecco, Veneto, Italy Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate. 101. Marlings Sparkling Rosé Brut, Sway, Hampshire, £70 England Fresh, fruity, vibrant and easy drinking sparkling wine with an accomplished raspberry essence. Light aromas of red fruits, strawberries and cherries, with an appealing fruit finish 102. Nyetimber Classic Cuvée, West Sussex, England (V) £90 Aromas of lemon, honey, brioche and spice whilst the palate is silken smooth with a lively acidity and a sweet lemon tart finish 103. Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut, Champagne, France £90 The Grand Brut has fine bubbles, which release deliciously floral, slightly honeyed fruit aromas. It shows fresh fruit such as white peach on the palate and has an elegant finish. 104. Gusbourne Brut Reserve, Kent, England £98 Highlights of red fruit aromas such as cherry and strawberry, then developing into notes of fresh pastry. The finish is clean and fresh and gives tones of citrus and stone fruit. 105. Bollinger, Special Cuvée Brut N.V, France £140 Bursting from the glass with aromas of honeyed apples, crisp stone fruit, buttery pastry, ripe lemons and fresh walnuts. Medium to full-bodied, fleshy and vinous, with a deep core of beautifully ripe fruit, racy acids and a pillowy mousse. 106. Laurent Perrier Rosé Champagne, France £155 Perfected at each stage of its making. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé is acknowledged for its consistency and its high quality. It is characterized by its ripe red fruit aromas, a high intensity and great freshness. 107. Perrier-Jouët Blanc de Blanc, Champagne, France £200 Enticing aromas of hedgerow flowers - elderberry, acacia and honeysuckle - and tangy citrus. On the palate, its mineral freshness lingers into a surprisingly smooth, mellow finish. £200 108. Perrier-Jouët Blason Rosé, Champagne, France A luminous rose colour with glints of pale orange. This Rosé unleashes intense aromas of ripe red and black fruit strawberry, raspberry and blackberry - complemented by a hint of exotic pomegranate. Lush and lively on the palate, it lingers into a full, generous finish. 109. Perrier-Jouët Belle Epoque Brut, Champagne, France £450 The famous Emile Gallé designed Art Nouveau bottle with its painted anemones has to be one of the most beautiful presentations on the market. The equally impressive contents have the classic elegance and finesse of great Champagne.

Saint Marc Grenache blanc, Pays d'Oc, France £31 Fresh, vibrant and bursting with aromas of grapefruit, pear and summer flowers with a joyful parade of lemon and lime flavours balanced by juicy acidity. £35 201. La Campagne, Viognier, Languedoc, France (V) Dry with all the classic characteristics of the Viognier grape, exhibiting peaches, dried apricots and floral aromas. 202. Petit Ronde Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France (V) £40 The mouth feel is delicate and has fresh notes of lemon/lime zest and pink grapefruit. The palate is full bodied - delicious ripe stone fruits, green apple and citrus with herb. 203. Pascal Clement, Macon Villages, Burgundy, France (V) £40 Floral and fruit aromas such as acacia and honeysuckle, lemongrass, and citrus mingle on a refreshing palate. £42 204 Domaine Du Haut Perron, Torraine Sauvignon Blanc, Loire. France Elegance and richness would be the perfect descriptors, with notes of citrus, apricot, and passion fruit notes with toasted oak. Remarkably long on the finish with toasted oak, herbs, and a flinty salinity on the finish. Boutinot La Fleur Solitaire Côtes du Rhône Blanc, 205. £45 Rhone, France (V) Fresh, medium-bodied, with a pretty nose of delicate hedgerow flowers and stone fruits. The palate is lovely and fresh showing fresh stone fruits, pear, and green apple with a honeyed, mineral finish. 206. Chablis Fournillon, Burgundy, France £60 A classically styled Chablis, generously rounded with green apple, citrus and a rounded yet mineral finish. 207. Pouilly Fume 'Argile a' S' bouchie, Chatellier, Loire, £84 France (V)This is a fresh and beautifully aromatic, mineral and fruity Pouilly Fume, which is elegant, and has plenty of length and a full body. Sauvigon Blanc in one of its best forms. 208. Chablis Premier Cru Fourchaume Domaine Alexandre, £95 Burgundy, France Crisp and refreshing on the nose with an abundance of orchard fruit, citrus and subtle flint notes that follow through onto a rich mineral driven palate. The finish is long and luscious. 209 Louis Jadot, Puligny Montrachet, Côtes de Beaune, £180 France Distinctively Côte de Beaune, overflowing with generous rich barrique character and stylish stone-fruit charm.

Orange Wine

210. Gerard Bertrand, Orange Gold, Occitanie, France (V) The nose is complex, with an explosion of white flower notes, candied fruits, and white pepper. In the mouth, a flattering aromatic freshness, with precise flavours and a pleasing balance thanks to the structure that give body and spirit.

- Italv 750ml 211. Pecorino Terre di Chieti Feudo Antico, Aburzzo, Italy £40 A fruity nose with mineral and floral notes. Medium bodied with delicate fruit flavours and almond on the finish. 212. Allumea, Organic Chardonnay/Grillo, Sicilia, Italy (V) £47 This wine has an elegant pale yellow hue, with intense aromas of pineapple and lemon. The palate is fresh and crisp, with a great minerality and a long and lingering finish. 213. Ca' Bianca, Gavi, Piedmont, Italy £45 White flower and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and refreshing minerality on the palate. Spain 214. Paco & Lola, Lolo Tree Albarino, Rias Baixas, Spain (V) £48 Notes of zippy, green apple and lemon peel with a hint of white-fleshed plum. 215. Ontañón Vetiver Rioja Blanco, Rioja, Spain (V) £50 Softly oak aged, with a balance between ripe tropical fruit and toasted brioche. Germany 216. Walt Riesling Pfalz ,Germany (V) £42 Off-dry, this wine has lovely flavours of peach and stone fruits with a hint of apricot lingering on a bright, succulent finish. Villa Wolf Gewürztraminer, Pfalz, Germany (V) £48 217 Clean, fruity and wonderfully light on its feet. With plenty of aromatic charm of elderflower, roses and lychee. Succulent and juicy on the palate with delicate stone fruits, spice notes and elderflower New World 750ml £40

301. Jaffelin, Pinot Noir, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France (V) A bouquet of explosive aromas of cherry and red fruits, with a soft complexity that is rich, yet still maintains great quality of tannins and great length.

302. M. Chapoutier, Cotes du Rhone Belleruche, France £42
 (V)
 Intense, with blackcurrant and raspberry on the nose and

hints of white pepper. Juicy, powerful, and full of red fruits on the palate.

- 303. Beaujolais-Villages, Mommessin Les Grandes Mises £42
 (V)
 With a fine ruby-red colour with flavours of small berrys, wellrounded, soft tannins and good length.
- 304. Chateau Lyonnat, Lussac Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, £48 France A small district of St Emilion with a common terrain, the style is full of soft plums and brambly cassis flavours.
- 305. Château de Fleurie Maison Loron & Fils, Beaujolais, £60 France (V)

Soft and silky with red cherry, raspberry, and a touch of earthy spice on the finish.

306. Bouchard Aine and Fils, Beaune Villages, France (V) £80

Cherry-red in colour, it shows red and black berry fruit on the nose and a note of vanilla on the palate.

307. Chateau l'Hopital de Mignot Saint Estephe, Bordeaux, £82 France

> This wine has a fruity and spicy nose, with a classic palette of cassis, cherry, liquorice and vanilla, all whilst displaying a full-bodied but delicate structure.

- 308. Châteauneuf du Pape, Les Clefs du Paradis, France £100 This wine is complex and elegant, with aromas of redcurrants, red cherries and black berries, with herbal flavours such as lavender, thyme and rosemary. The wine shows very subtle oaky notes, bringing complexity and length.

310. Louis Jadot, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Côtes de Nuits, £140 France

The colour of this wine is a lovely light ruby. The tannins are supple. Les Saints-Georges is a subtle, fruity wine with some notes of spice.

 311. Gevrey-Chambertin, Bouchard Aîné & Fils, Côtes de £150 Nuits, France (V)
 This wine has a full-bodied palate is powerful with spice

notes and truffles punctuating the plump ripe fruit flavours.

312. Masseria Borgo Dei Trulli Lucale Primitivo Appasimento £42 IGP Puglia, Italy

Juicy with incredible concentration. Aromas of blackcurrant, vanilla and chocolate. The palate is velvety, elegant and complex.

- 313. Uggiano Chianti Riserva Fagiano, Tuscany, Italy (V) £48 A perfectly balanced and elegant Chianti, soft red cherry, plum and warming spices with a touch of balsamic on the finish.
- 314.Barolo Flori, Piemonte, Italy (V)£60Robust and complex combining mulberry, ripe strawberry
and brown spice with a lengthy finish.£60

315. Mirador Rioja Reserva, Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain £45 Distinguished fruits with toasted spice and a delicately balsamic bouquet. This Reserva is an unctuous, delicate vintage, with suitable maturing and ageing.
