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

### Champagne & Sparkling

125ml 750mll

Da Luca Prosecco, Veneto, Italy

£9 £52

Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

Hattingley Valley Brut Reserve, Hampshire, England £15 £88

Delicate aromas of lemon zest and orange peel and honeysuckle with green apple and freshly baked brioche on the palate.

Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut, Champagne, France

£17.50 £103

This Grand Brut has fine bubbles, which release deliciously floral, slightly honeyed fruit aromas. It shows fresh fruit such as white peach on the palate and has an elegant finish.

Perrier-Jouët Blanc de Blanc, Champagne, France £33 £195

Enticing aromas of hedgerow flowers – elderberry, acacia, and honeysuckle – and tangy citrus. On the palate, its mineral freshness lingers into a surprisingly smooth, mellow finish.

Saint Marc Grenache blanc, Pays a'Oc, £5.50 £7.50 £11 £31 France (V)

Fresh, vibrant and bursting with aromas of grapefruit, pear and summer flowers with a joyful parade of lemon and lime flavours balanced by juicy acidity.

La Campagne, Viognier, Languedoc, £6 £8.50 £12 £34 France (V)

Dry with all the classic characteristics of the Viognier grape, exhibiting peaches, dried apricots and floral aromas.

Petal & Stem, Sauvignon Blanc, £7 £9.50 £14 £40 Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand

This wine expresses pure fruit flavours of guava and passionfruit, with underlying notes of grapefruit and blackcurrant leaf, combining to create a wine that is refreshingly zesty and nicely balanced on the finish.

Allumea, Organic Chardonnay/Grillo, £7 £9.50 £14 £40 Sicilia, Italy (V)

This wine has an elegant pale yellow hue, with intense aromas of pineapple and lemon. The palate is fresh and crisp, with a great minerality and a long and lingering finish..

Paco & Lola, Albarino, Rias Baixas, £8 £11.30 £16 £46 Spain (V)

Expressive nose of green apples, pear and lemons, with hints of herbs and flower blossom. The palate is clean and textured with notes of pineapple and mango intermingled with refreshing citrus flavours amplified by minerality.

#### Rosé Wine

A delicate pink wine full of fresh, summer-fruit aromas and flavours.

'M' Minuty Côtes de Provence, France £8 £11.30 £16 £46

Red-berry notes dominate the wine's bouquet. The crisp, juicy fruits are round and appetizing on the palate. A slight touch of sweetness tempers this vivacious vintage, a splendid introduction to the rosés of Provence.

Classic notes of red berry, blackcurrant and cherry fruits. Clean and persistent on the finish.

Wee Angus Merlot, Central Victoria, £8 £11 £16 £46 Australia

The youthful exuberance of Wee Angus is revealed through the gentle plummy characters of Merlot. A subtle touch of vanillin oak and a generous finish.

Amodo Pinot Noir, IGT Pavia, Italy (V) £7 £9.50

Fresh and expressive flavors of dark cherries, forest raspberries, sweet licorice and garden herbs. The tannins are small and round, the acidity elegantly fresh, and the body medium-bodied.

Chateau Lyonnat, Lussac Saint Emilion, £8 £11.30 £16 £46 Bordeaux, France

A small district of St Emilion with a common terrain, the style is full of soft plums and brambly cassis flavours.

Nieto Senetiner Malbec, Mendoza, £8 £11.30 £16 £46 Argentina (V)

Soft and juicy with flavours of berries, plum, figs and a smoky vanilla finish.

#### Fortified & Sweet Wine

Nieto Chateau Grand Jauga Sauternes France (V)

A delicious combination of honeysuckle, apricot and marmalade, sweetness and acidity in perfect balance

Nieto Cascinone Palazzina, Muscato d'Asti, £7 Piedmont, Italy (V)

This Muscato reveals fresh and inviting notes of ripe apricot, peach, and honeysuckle, with a zesty citrus and grapefruit bite on the persistent finish

Chapoutier Bila-Haut Banyuls Rimage, Banyuls, £11 France

This Banyuls has a powerful nose, shifting between black fruit and red berries, giving it a lovely freshness, subtly complemented by notes of cocoa. Great persistency with sweetness which develops gradually.

Royal Tokaji Blue Label 5 Puttonyos, Hungary

A medium amber colour with a nose of orange peel, figs and cinnamon. The sugar on the palate is well-balanced by the fine acidity, leading to a clean, refreshing finish.

Fernando de Castilla Classic Pedro Ximenez, Jerez, £12 Spain (V)

The palate shows an array of flavours from coffee, liquorice, sweet tobacco and prunes to figs, raisins, tea and a dozen other fleeting scents. A decadent wine, that everyone must try at least once.

Warre's LBV 2008, Douro, Portugal

The backbone provided by the large Touriga Nacional component is evident in the fragrant, floral nose of roses and violets. The palate is generous and sumptuous with black fruit and liquorice flavours, balanced delicately tannins.

Kopke 10 Year Old Tawny Port, Douro, Portugal

Kopke 10 Year old is lusciously smooth with complex notes of sweet spice and rich dried fruits balanced alongside honey and subtle wood. An endlessly long finish, this is a great choice with an array of desserts from chocolate brownies to crumble. The perfect after-dinner digestif!
